

How to burn a data CD or DVD with Roxio (7/22/2009)

1. Launch Roxio from either the CADL Quickstart menu (A) or the Windows Start menu (B)

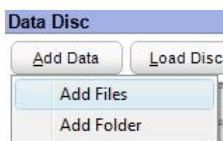


2. Select the appropriate project from the “Frequent Tasks” menu on the right. The standard burning option is “Data Disc”, although “Audio Disc” (used for making a music CD that will play in a CD player) and “Disc Copy” are also useful.

3. For this example, we will make a data disc. Click “Data disc.”



4. Insert a blank disc into the disc drive. Roxio will automatically recognize whether it was a CD or DVD, and give you the corresponding amount of free space. A blank DVD contains roughly 6.5 times as much data as a blank CD.
5. Click the “Add Data” button, click “Add Files”, then browse to the location of the files using the dropdown box (typically G: “patron data” drive.) Double click on the file you wish to add. Repeat until you have all the files needed.



Note: If you wish, you can instead click and drag files into the open area in the center of Roxio. Copy & Paste also works.

6. Once you've gotten all your files added to the project, click the large red circle in the bottom right corner of the screen to start burning.



How to make an Audio CD

1. The process is identical to the data CD creation process, except you select "Audio CD" rather than "Data disc"
2. Note that when you add files, it will only show file types that are supported by Roxio (mp3, wma, wav, cda, m4a, wpl, asx, m3u, mp4.) It does not support, and hence cannot burn, other file types such as .flac, .ogg, or .rm.

How to copy a disc

1. Select "Copy Disc", insert the disc you wish to copy into the disc drive, hit the large red circle in the bottom right corner of the screen.
2. When prompted, insert a blank disc of the same or greater capacity as the original (example: If you are copying a DVD, you'll need to insert a blank DVD.) Respond to the confirmation box begin burning on the blank disc.
