Included are two books written by Helen Earley and James Walkinshaw about the history of Oldsmobile. Also included in this collection is a set of oral history interviews made by Helen Earley and James Walkinshaw.

Biographical Note

Helen Jones Earley (1917-2005) was an automotive historian, author and Oldsmobile employee for more than 50 years. She was also involved with many community organizations.

Helen and her twin Bernice were born on a farm in Montcalm County Michigan, September 4, 1917. She graduated from Sheridan High School in 1935, attended Lansing's Acme Business College then Purdue. After college she took a position with the Agricultural Department of Georgia. Family obligations returned her to Michigan, and she soon began working at Oldsmobile. She moved between several departments. On January 27, 1943 she began in the Olds Sales Budget Department. In the building's lobby was a large painting titled *Setting the Pace*. It showed a 1910 Olds Limited racing the New York Central. That piece sparked her interest in Oldsmobile history. Her interest in ads and sales literature led her to begin the collection that would become part of the Oldsmobile History Center.

Through the next several decades she continued to work in various departments, notably PR and Sales. In 1966 Helen married Bill Early. He passed in 1984. In 1972, Olds 75th anniversary, Helen provided the newly formed Oldsmobile Club of American with hundreds of photos, manuals and reference pieces for the library.

In 1977 she began working with Jim Walkinshaw. They shared a passion for Olds and began a collaboration which culminated in writing two books on Oldsmobile. Walkinshaw retired in 1986. When Helen retired in 1987, the pair assumed management of the Olds Historical Collection. They gathered smaller collections from a dozen places to form the Oldsmobile History Center. In 1989 they started an oral history program utilizing Olds retirees as subjects. They traveled cross-country gathering interviews, compiling over 180, and making it at the time the largest single company oral history collection in the country. They continued to work on the book throughout.

In 1997, the 100th anniversary of Oldsmobile approached and their book neared completion, but had not title. One night Jim woke with *Setting the Pace* stuck in his mind, the name of the painting Helen had seen in 1943. They had their title. Publication coincided with the anniversary kickoff. All three national car clubs participated and over 2,000 classic cars descended on Lansing.

Helen and Jim finished a second book, *Oldsmobile a War Years Pictorial*, an all photo book on Olds war efforts. Helen retired in 2000 from the History Center.

When GM decided to eliminate the Olds brand the History Center was combined with other GM historical collections at the GM Heritage Center in Sterling Heights, Michigan. The collection Helen and Jim spent 50 years collecting in Lansing moved to the Detroit area. On April 29, 2004 Helen stood with Jim at the end of the line in the Lansing Assembly Plant to watch the very last Oldsmobile come off the line.

Helen became ill in December, 2004 and passed away January 8, 2005. An article in the Lansing State Journal dated Sunday January 20, 2005 reports on a memorial to Helen Jones Early. Its title was *Friends bid farewell to 'first lady of Oldsmobile*. It describes her as "one of the automaker's best ambassadors".

Among her many achievements and associations are; founding member of the task force which created the RE Olds Transportation museum, Board Member of the Detroit Public Library National Automotive History Collection, Board Member of the Library and Research Center for the Antique Automobile Club of America and the Society of Automotive Historians, recipient of the James J. Bradley Award from the Society of Automotive Historians, co-author of *Setting the Pace: Oldsmobile's First 100 Years* and *Oldsmobile-A War Year Pictorial*, member of the Sunrise Rotary Club, reader for WKAR Radio, active with the Michigan Women's Hall of Fame, Turner Dodge House, Potter Park Zoo, member of three national Oldsmobile Car Clubs and the local Oldsmobile Car Club.

Collection Scope and Content Note

This collection contains a large set of newsletters and other publications written for the workers in GM automobile factories, with the majority being focused on Lansing automobile plants. These include publications for specific departments or populations, such as: Delta Diesel News, Powertrain Communication, Product Engineering News, Lansing Fab Feature Line and Line Times, along with some more general GM publications. Except for a run of Lansing Labor News from 1957 to 1961, most of the materials have publication dates of the 1980's and 1990's.

This collection also contains 129 photographs of Oldsmobile cars, including historical, advertising and concept car photographs. A set of Oldsmobile automotive service manuals cover models from 1961 through 1989. Also included is are DVDs, CDs, a VHS tape and publications about the history of Oldsmobile and the history of Ingham County. Two books by Helen Earley and James Walkinshaw are in the collection, Oldsmobile: A war years pictorial and Setting the pace: Oldsmobile's first 100 years. A large collection of oral history interviews of former and current Oldsmobile and GM employees and a few of relatives or acquaintances of the Olds family are also included in this collection.

Arrangement

Newsletter and plant publications are arranged by title, then chronologically by year of publication, other materials are arranged by subject and date. Oral history interview tapes are arranged alphabetically according to the name of the interviewee.
