**Abstract:**

This collection comprises the majority of Eugene G. Wanger's personal library of books, manuscripts and ephemera pertaining to the history of Ingham County, Michigan and included in his bibliographical 2003 publication *Discovering Ingham County*.

## Administrative Information

**Access Restrictions:**

This collection is open for research. Access is by appointment only. No walk-ins are allowed. Appointments are scheduled a minimum of 24 hours in advance, and are granted as staff time permits. Please contact the Mason library to schedule an appointment. Researchers must complete a research application and an item request slip at the time of their appointment. A valid state issued identification card with picture and current address is required to use this collection. Access will not be granted less than 1 hour prior to closing on any day. Researchers may only use 1 item at a time. Ink pens are not allowed when using this collection. It is forbidden to mark or alter items in any way. Creating visual reproductions by any means other than hand and pencil is not permitted. This restriction includes, but is not limited to, photocopying, photographing, scanning or any digital reproductions. Researchers wishing to obtain images from this collection must go through the Capital Area District Library's Local History Reference Librarian. Contact information is available at the Mason library, the Main branch in Lansing and at the website [www.cadl.org](http://www.cadl.org). It is strongly encouraged that researchers use circulating or reference copies of titles found in this collection when available outside the collection. If additional copies are readily available access may be restricted. Any infractions may result in the loss of access privileges and lawful prosecution.

Due to the fragile condition of specific items, access may be restricted. Fragile items are designated with an asterisk (\*) in the [series section](#) of this document. For use of items designated fragile please contact the Capital Area District Library's Local History Reference Librarian. **Biographical Note**

Born in May, 1933, to Eugene M. and Roka Gilkison Wanger in Chicago, Illinois, Eugene G. Wanger moved to Lansing, Michigan, as an infant. In school he participated in drama and debate, was interested in nature and won several forensic contests. He received accolades as a magician, which he began studying at the age of eight. He was a member of the International Brotherhood of Magicians and later entertained American Troops overseas for the Department of Defense. He attended Lansing Sexton High School and worked as a Y.M.C.A camp counselor.

For his undergraduate degree Mr. Wanger attended Amherst College in Massachusetts. Following his degree he attended the University of Michigan Law School in Ann Arbor. It was in law school that he met his future wife, an Ingham County native, Marilyn Morris.

After law school both Eugene and Marilyn worked as attorneys. He had his own private law practice, and at one time was Lansing City Attorney. She served as an Assistant Attorney General, and later as Commissioner for the Michigan Court of Appeals. Mr. Wanger was a delegate to the State of Michigan Constitutional Convention in 1961-1962, where he authored the state's constitutional ban on the death penalty, and since 1972 has co-chaired the Michigan Committee Against Capital Punishment. He wrote three books and contributed to and worked on numerous historical publications and civil projects. He was a member of the Jaycees, Rotary International, the Ingham County Board of Commissioner and was one of the original incorporators of the Friends of the Lansing Public Library.

## **Collection Scope and Content Note**

These holdings were collected and produced by Mr. Wanger over a period of several decades. The majority of the collection was acquired. However, the collection includes both published and unpublished material from Mr. Wanger himself. There are books, maps, atlases, newspapers, reports, small press publications and ephemera. The time span covered by this collection dates from 1849 to 2001. His bibliography *Discovering Ingham County* was published in 2003, and is a sequel to his 1977 publication *Ingham County Histories: An Annotated Bibliography for Students, Buffs and Collectors*.

## **Arrangement**

This collection contains 17 boxes and 89 shelved books. The [shelved books](#) are organized alphabetically by author's last name. The series titles and organization are the same system Mr. Wanger developed. However, the box location of items varies due to constraints on box size and the fragile nature of some items. For inventory purposes, a separate listing of items per box and [shelf listing of books](#) by item number identified in Wanger's bibliography are included below. Additionally, a list of items found in "*Discovering Ingham County*", but [exempted](#) from The Morris Collection, is also included.
