Read CADL eBooks without downloading any apps or software. You can read many eBooks in our collection by using OverDrive READ on your computer, tablet, or smartphone's web browser.

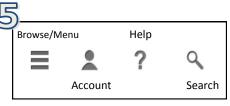
Browsing and Checking Out eBooks

- 1. In your web browser, open www.cadl.org/downloads.
- 2. Scroll down the page, select either MCLS OverDrive Catalog or MCLS OverDrive for Kids.
- 3. The MCLS OverDrive Library will open. Type in or select Capital Area District Library from the list of libraries.
- 4. Sign In with your library card number. Enter your complete library card number and select

Sign In. Select Remember my login information on this device if you want this information saved for future use.

5. Browse for a book by pressing the menu button or search for a specific title or author by pressing the magnifying glass and typing in your search in the box to the left.



- OverDrive has some icons that you may want to be familiar with.
 - a. 4 titles that CADL has bought specifically for CADL, not MCLS, patrons.
 - b. Black open book—available eBook.
 - Gray open book—eBook that you'll have to place a hold on.
 - Black headphones— available audiobook.
 - Gray headphones—audiobook that you'll have to place a hold on.









- Check if the book you've found is available to read in your browser by pressing the cover. If one of the Available Formats on the right hand side says Over-Drive READ, select **Borrow**.
 - If OverDrive READ is not listed in Available Formats, this is one of the few books that would need to be downloaded to your computer or device. Please use the appropriate guide for

instructions on that process.



• If the book is not available, there will be a button that says **Place a Hold.** If you enter your email address after selecting **Place a Hold**, you will receive an email when the book is available. OverDrive then gives you 72 hours to borrow the book on hold.

- The title can be borrowed up to 21 days. You can change that time period before you press **Borrow**.
- If a title is available to renew, the option will become available within 3 days of expiration.
- You will NOT have overdue fines from an eBook.
- 7. When you select **Borrow**, you will be sent to your bookshelf. Select **Read (In your browser)**. Your eBook should then show up in your web browser.

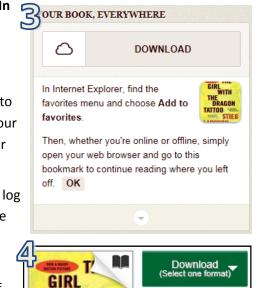
Reading Your eBook

- The first time you open a book in your browser, you are given tips on how to navigate the book. There is also a **Table of Contents**, on the right side of your web browser's screen. You can also **Search** the book and keep track of your **Bookmarks & Highlights** on the right side of the screen.
- When you are finished reading, simply close your web browser. When you log back into your account at, http://ebooks.mcls.org/, select Account, find the book on your Bookshelf, and select Read (In your browser. The book will open to the page where you left off.
- 3. To read without an Internet connection, select **Download** at the bottom of the webpage of the open book in OverDrive READ. Follow the directions, to the right, to add the book to your web browser's favorites.

Returning an eBook Early

In CADL's eBook collection (<u>ebooks.mcls.org</u>), go to your **Account**. Select **Bookshelf** and select **Return Title**.
