Elk shooting in Colorado.
Elk are found in almost every part of the Park, generally in the timbered country on the mountain slopes, singly or in bands of ten and fifteen according to the season. With proper care they can be obtained as early as 150 yards, but a good hunter who "jumps" a herd at 500 yards will bag three-fourths of the number before they are out of range.
