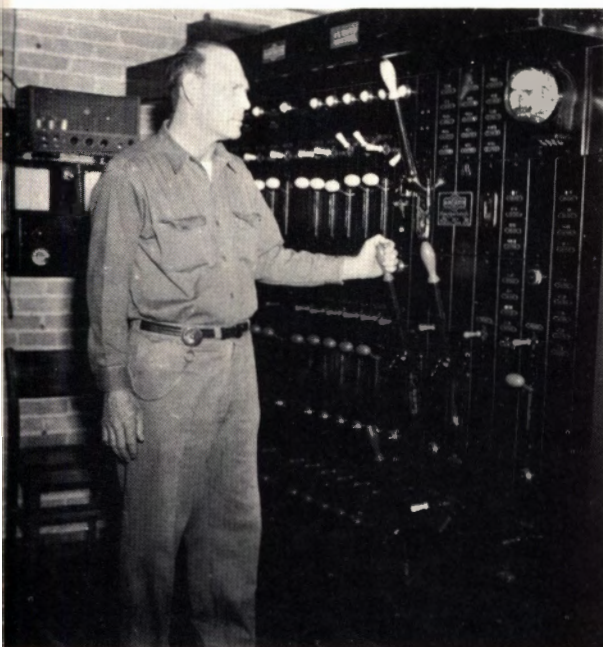
Office Staff

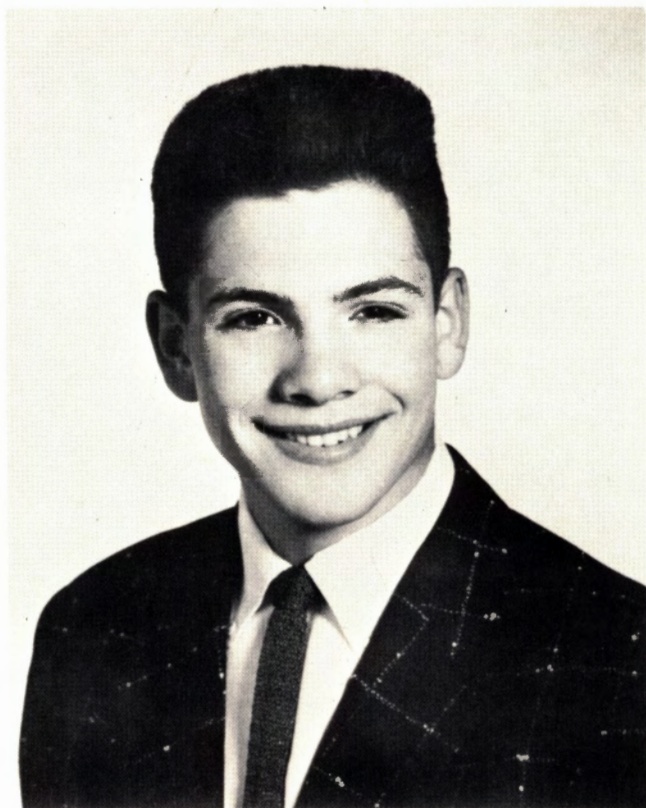
Maintenance

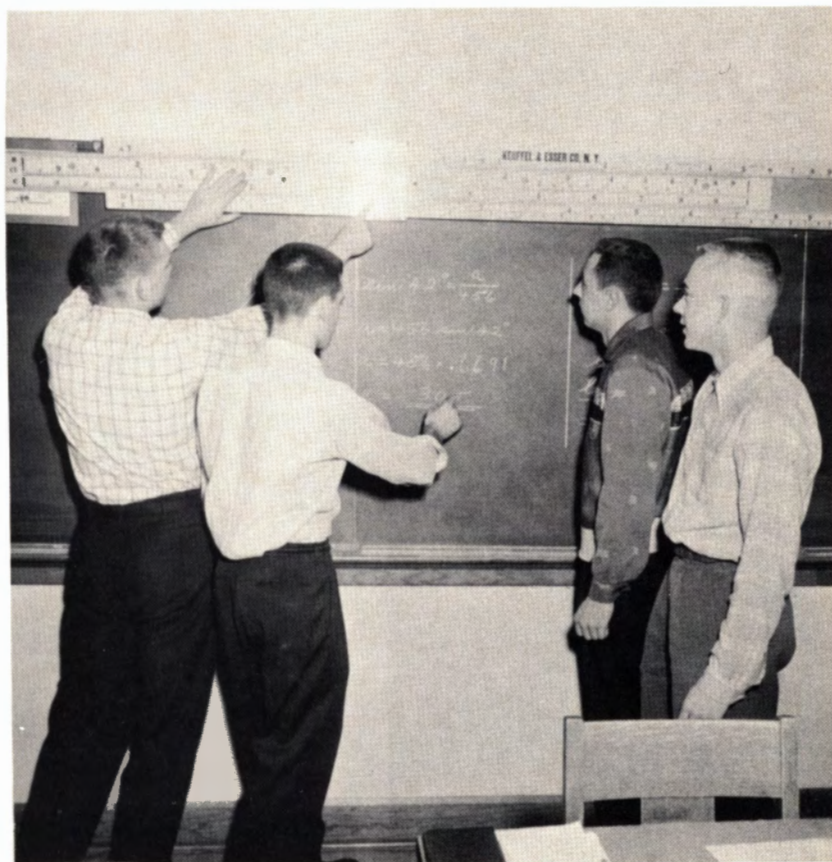

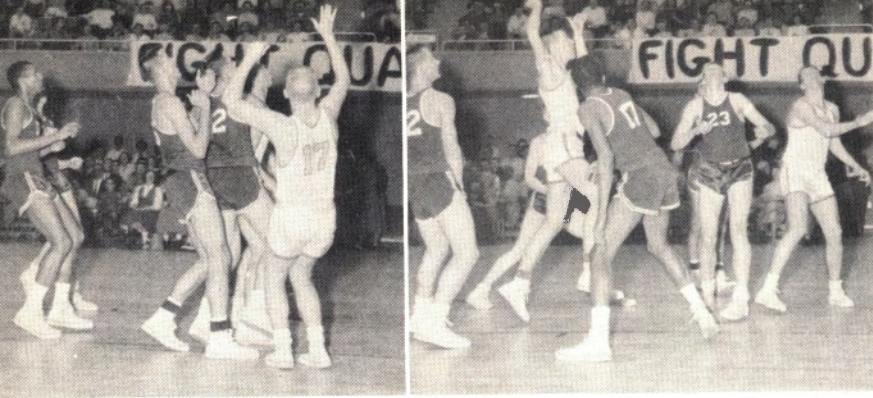

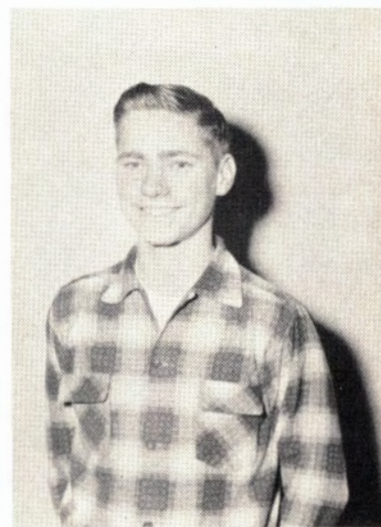
