BigShot Die Cutter Quick Start


Thanks for checking out the Sizzix Big Shot Die Cutting Machine!

All the die cuts provided in this kit are what Sizzix calls Originals or Bigz. They all work the same way. You can cut many different materials, including: cardstock, paper, construction paper, fabric, felt, flexible magnet, grungepaper, vellum, and more. Note, when you cut thicker materials, you will have to decrease the amount you cut at one time.


Sizzix does offer other types of die and embossing tools. If you have access to these, please see the back of this sheet to learn how to use them.

Using Originals, Bigz or Bigz XL Dies



1. Place an Originals or Bigz die on a Cutting Pad with foam side up. Place paper or desired material to be cut on top of the die. Place the second Cutting Pad or Premium Crease Pad on top of the paper or material to create a "sandwich."




2. Slide the "sandwich" into the opening of the Big Shot. Note the rotation of the handle and continue to rotate it in the same direction until the sandwich has passed through the opening of the rollers. Remove the "sandwich" from Big Shot. Your die-cut shape is ready to use!

Note: Currently the library does not offer dies with a crease or any Bigz XL Dies.

BigShot Die Cutter Advanced Use

Note: These dies and embossing tools are not included in the CADL Library of Things Kit. Directions are provided here for those with access to these pieces.




 Place Sizzlits die onto a Cutting Pad with foam side up. Place paper over the die. Place another Cutting Pad over the paper to create a "sandwich"




2. Place "sandwich" on Extended Multipurpose Platform and slide Platform into opening of Big Shot. Note the rotation of the handle and continue to rotate it in the same direction until the Platform has passed through the opening and the rollers. Remove Platform from Big Shot. Your die-cut shape is ready to use!

Using Framelits, Thinlits, Triplits or Wafer-Thin Dies




 Place material to be die-cut on Cutting Pad. Place die over paper or photo and align. Place another Cutting Pad over the die and paper to create a "sandwich."




 Place "sandwich" on Extended Multipurpose Platform and slide Platform into opening of Big Shot. Note the rotation of the handle and continue to rotate it in the same direction until the Platform has passed through the opening and the rollers. Remove Platform from Big Shot. Your die-cut shape is ready to use!


Using Textured Impressions, Texture Fades, Texture Trades Embossing Folders or Embosslits Dies



 With Textured Impressions, Texture Fades, Texture Trades Embossing Folder or Embosslits die open, insert paper, foil or other embossable material, then close like a book.




A. Place Cutting Pad above and below the closed folder to create a "sandwich."



 Place "sandwich" on Extended Multipurpose Platform and slide Platform into opening of Big Shot. Note the rotation of the handle and continue to rotate it in the same direction until the Platform has passed through the opening and the rollers. Remove Platform from Big Shot. Your embossed material is ready to use!
