DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- In September, the Board received an anonymous letter addressed to them regarding staff members at the Downtown Lansing Library. Issues addressed in this letter were spoken about with the circulation staff members.
- The Mobile Library began visiting the VFW Home on Saturdays and patrons have thoroughly enjoyed it! The preschool at the VFM has attended storytimes at the Aurelius Library.
- CADL's Local History Online is listed on the MeL Michigana Gateway website.
- CADL hosted a CADL Friends-only workshop on Monday, October 17. It was a successful event
 with 34 people in attendance. Letters of appreciation to our Friends Groups were mailed and
 posters were displayed in our libraries. CADL appreciates the efforts of our Friends Groups.
- Executive Director, Maureen Hirten, attended the co-op advisory council meeting with CADL's Marketing Director, Trent Smiley. Mr. Smiley's marketing efforts were highlighted by the meeting speaker.
- Melissa Cole, Dansville Head Librarian, partnered with the Questors, a local historical group, for a tour of the Fairview Cemetery in Dansville. High school students dressed up in costumes portraying the deceased's life to tour attendees.
- The weekly Okemos ESOL classes have grown. 25 children, plus their parents are using this library service. Because of its growth, an additional Okemos Library staff member conducts these classes.
- Quarterly, an informational e-newsletter is sent to our municipalities and this quarter's will be sent shortly.
- E. coli was found in the well at the Dansville Library. During the remedial process, the library restrooms were out of order.
- Newberry Medal award-winning author Matt de le Peña will be speaking at the South Lansing Library on November 3 at 6:30 pm. Mr. Peña's books feature themes of identity, diversity and acceptance for young adults.
- Aneesa Iqbal, Holt-Delhi Library, hosts a weekly robot zone. Small robots race around and are controlled by the library's iPad minis. The robots are capable of going up ramps and through mazes.
- The MLA Annual Conference will take place on October 26-28 and 35 CADL staff members will be attending.
- Staff at the Williamston Library were locked out of the library for the second time. The key holder
 was late to unlock the building each time. Julie Chrisinske, Head Librarian, has received her own
 building key.
- Pat Taylor, Finance Director, was informed that the Mason Library would receive a free boiler and water heater from Consumers Energy. Consumers Energy has a strong interest in helping the area's historical buildings be up to date.
