Raising Readers Backpack

- Talk with your child about the items in the kit. Ask what he or she thinks the stories might be about.
- Listen to the music on the CD or watch the DVD together. Play with the toys included in the backpack.
- After finishing one of the stories, imagine what might happen next.

Llama Fingerplay

Movement Rhyme

Llama, llama reach up high. Llama, llama blink your eyes. Llama, llama touch your toes. Llama, llama wiggle your nose. Llama, llama stomp and pout. Llama, llama jump about. Llama, llama clap your feet. Llama, llama take a seat.

Llama Chant

(Make a "Ilama" with your hand by putting all your fingers on your thumb but pointing your index finger and pinky finger upwards)

Happy llama / upright llama

Sad llama / point llama down

Totally rad llama / shake llama to the side

Super Ilama / scoop Ilama upward

Drama llama / make llamas kiss

Big fat momma llama / join two llamas together by putting pointer fingers down
