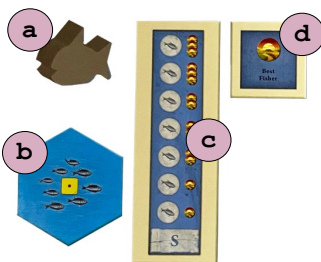
Game pieces are listed differently for this game. The game specifies how to sort/bag the game for ease of play and quicker setup time. Each bag is labeled with given sorting information.

7. Standard Hexes & Number tokens bag:
 - 16 standard terrain hexes (8 green moon-icon backs, 8 orange sun-icon backs)

 - 12 number tokens
8. 4 Player Pieces bags in four colors (orange, blue, white, red), each containing:
 - 4 harbor settlements
 - 9 crews
 - 3 ships
