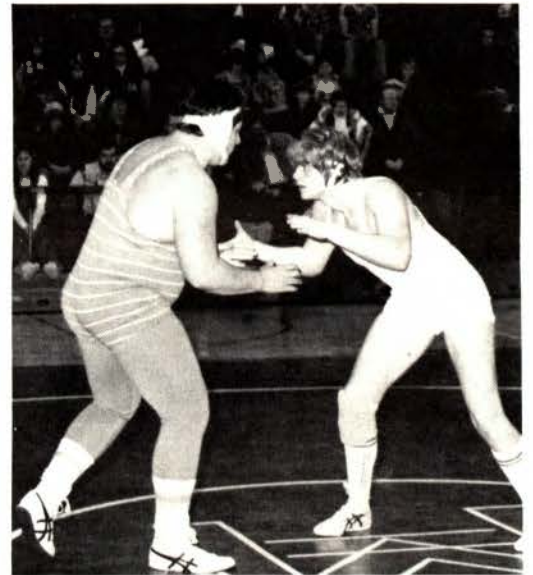
Wrestling

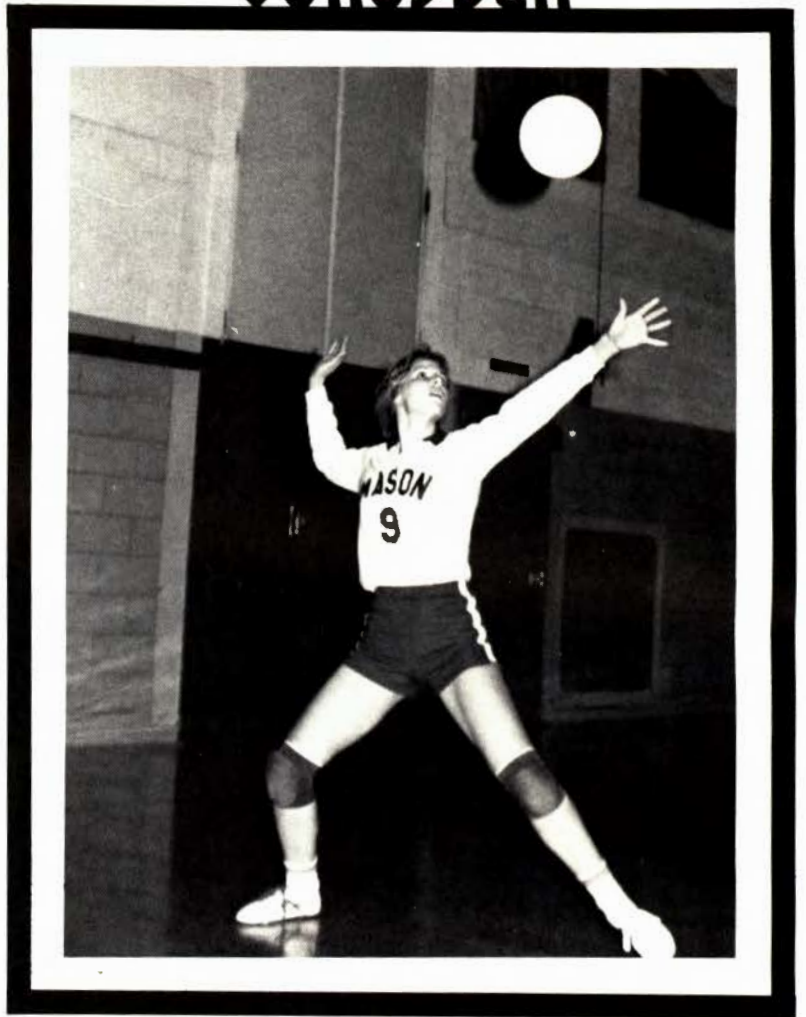
