Most growers have made compounds of their own, and these have been used in the complicated formulae, which they prepared. About the value of wood ash, our manure and our fertilizer, however, there is no difference, and we find them used by a large majority of the planters here.

day years, reckoning exports and imports on the including exports, is found to be in our favor to the extent of 100,000,000. That is to say, we have exported more than we have imported. This is a little more than the net exportation of specie, so that our balance of payments is not in a commercial balance, strictly speaking, but probably by pay interest on our foreign obligations. The balance of payments of specie for some years have not been to our annual production. The balance of trade of 1871 was not only the same and on the same side, but exports and imports continued to show great reductions in value, and, by no means an equal reduction in the value of merchandise. It is true that has been the decline of prices both at home and abroad that we are, to-day, buying and selling for less than the same amount of money than five years ago. Perhaps the bulk of our foreign trade is now as great as it was then, the money value of our imports was 20 per cent. more than now. It has fallen 10 per cent. more than it was then.
