NEWS OF THE WEEK.

FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE.

Spain.—The Pope having granted a dispensation for the marriage of the daughter of the American sculptor Story, a Protestant, with the Catholic Countess of Bona, the grant is passed as a remarkable exception to the rule never before broken in the Pontifical of Pius IX. The Pope's action is considered "unprecedented" and highly displeasing.

England.—Mr. Disraeli has offered in the British Parliament a bill adding another title to the Queen Victoria, "The Empress of India."

England has ordered her fleet in Chinese waters to back the Germans in bullying China into paying a large sum of depredations of Chinese shipping.

The war in Spain is being presented, on the part of the Government, with unusual vigor.

Several substantial victories over the Carlists have been won, and the Government is bent on concentrating their forces for a final struggle.

A special telegram from Vienna says: "The Bosphorus authorities have issued a manifesto against Count Andrassy's order. The manifesto points on the Porte's former breaches of promised reforms and demands that he be recalled."

The Bosphorus is every day expected to revolt if the attempt is made to evict the reformers from the fortifications, and they appeal to the justice of Europe."

Count Vor Asztrai.—has been summoned to Berlin to stand trial on a charge of plotting to assassinate the Emperor. It is said that the Count has decided to disclose his summons.

A dissident element, headed by a brother of a well-known person in the English channel, is reported by cable. An iron steamer, the Strathclyde, bound from London to an English port, put into Dover Bay for a pilot, and was captured by a British gunboat.
