Don and Leone Drasmore put a small stock of groceries in the fromt half of what was then E. C. Smith \& Soms meat market at 350 S. deffrerson street. The Smiths continued to operate the meat de-
partment and the store was renamed Jefferson Food Market. Prior to that time, Don Densmore had been employed by the Kroger Groerry and Baking Co. in the Mason store and by the A \& P stores in Mason and Lansiug, by Doyle Burgess' Standard Service and was on Rapids.

Leone Densmore had bernemployed at the Ingham County News offies following graduation from Cleary College in $\mathbf{Y}_{\mathrm{p}}$ silanti. The Densmores were married in Feloruary of 1036.

At the beginuing of World War II, the Smiths discontinued their meat busimess and the drpartment was taken over by the Densmores.
Don Densmore cultered the service in 1943 and for the 3 years he was Donay the store was operated by his wife. Upon his return, a fresh meat department was again started with George Gorham as manarer

In Junc of 1954 the downown Mason store was closed and a new location purechased in the Angell subdivision on US-127. At that time, The Drismores joined the IGA voluntary group of independent promore space was added to the floor area and stock roollines. In 1955
