All of our games were exciting to watch. With a few breaks in key situations, the season could have been completely reversed in wins and losses.

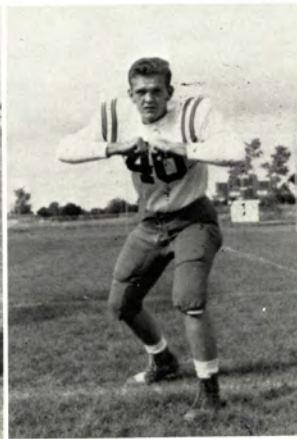

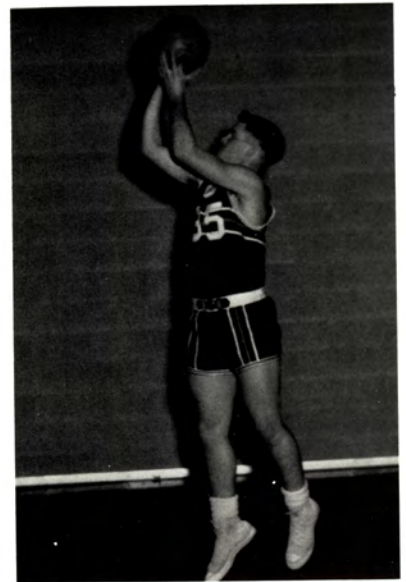
Highlights of the season were a three point loss to Class A Lansing Everett, and a surprise upset victory over always strong Jackson St. Johns.

Jim Landfair was the elected captain, and scoring leader with a 10 plus average.

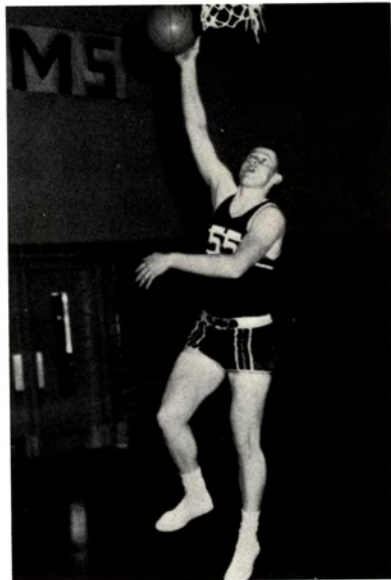
