Karate Club



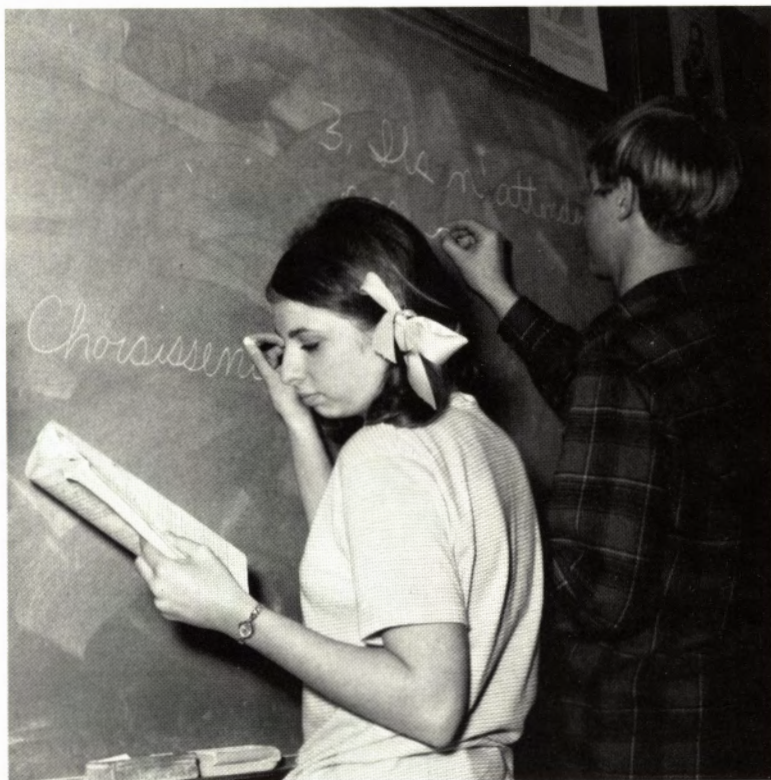

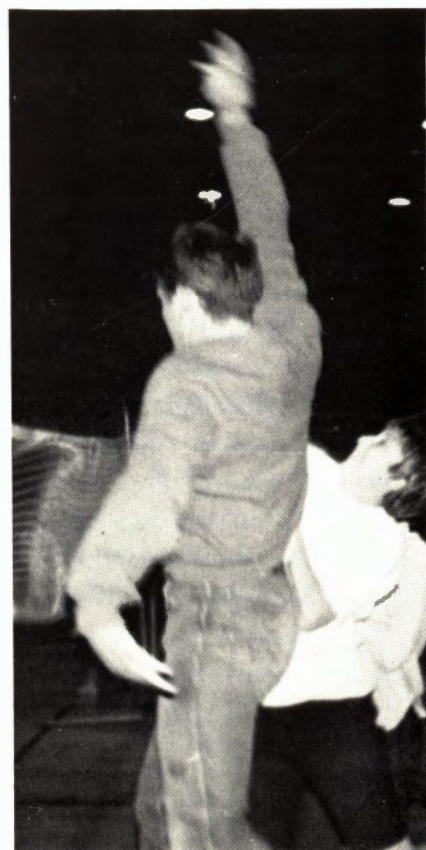

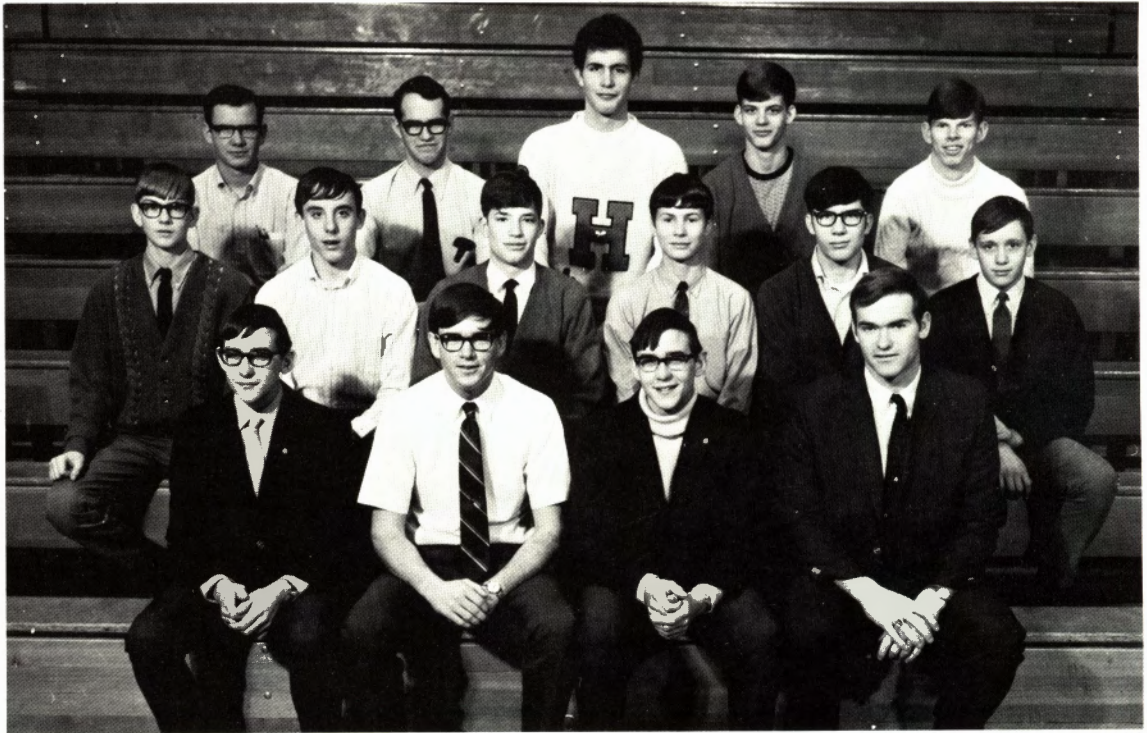

Key Club

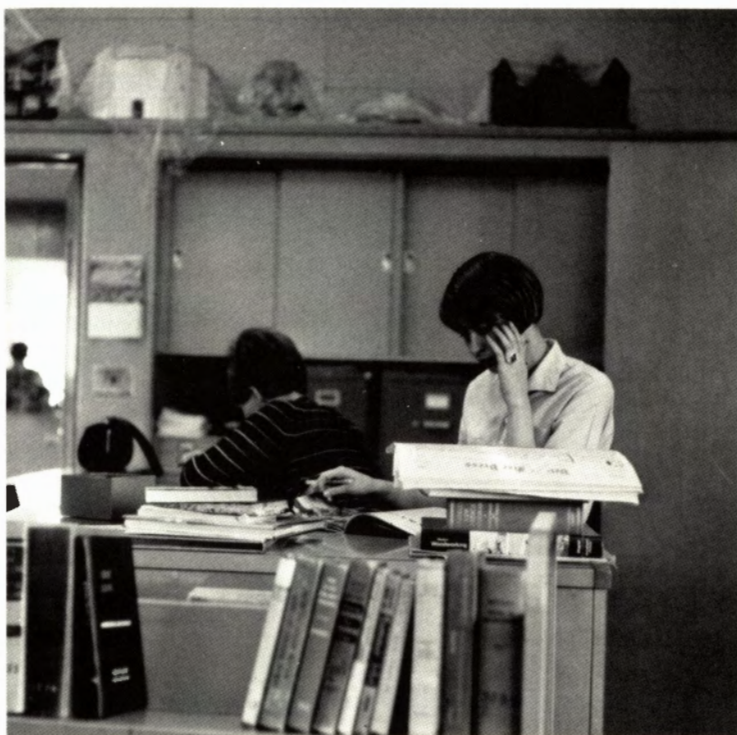

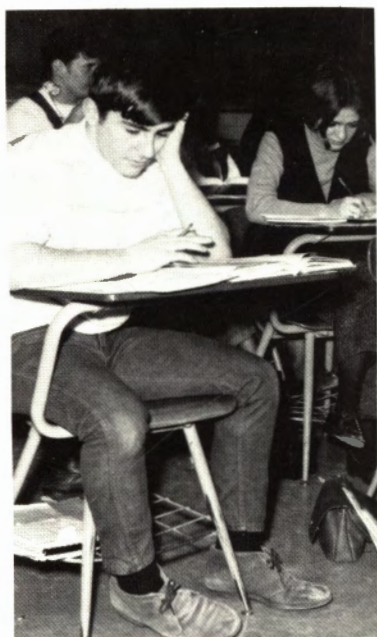


STUDENT GOVERNMENT SENATE

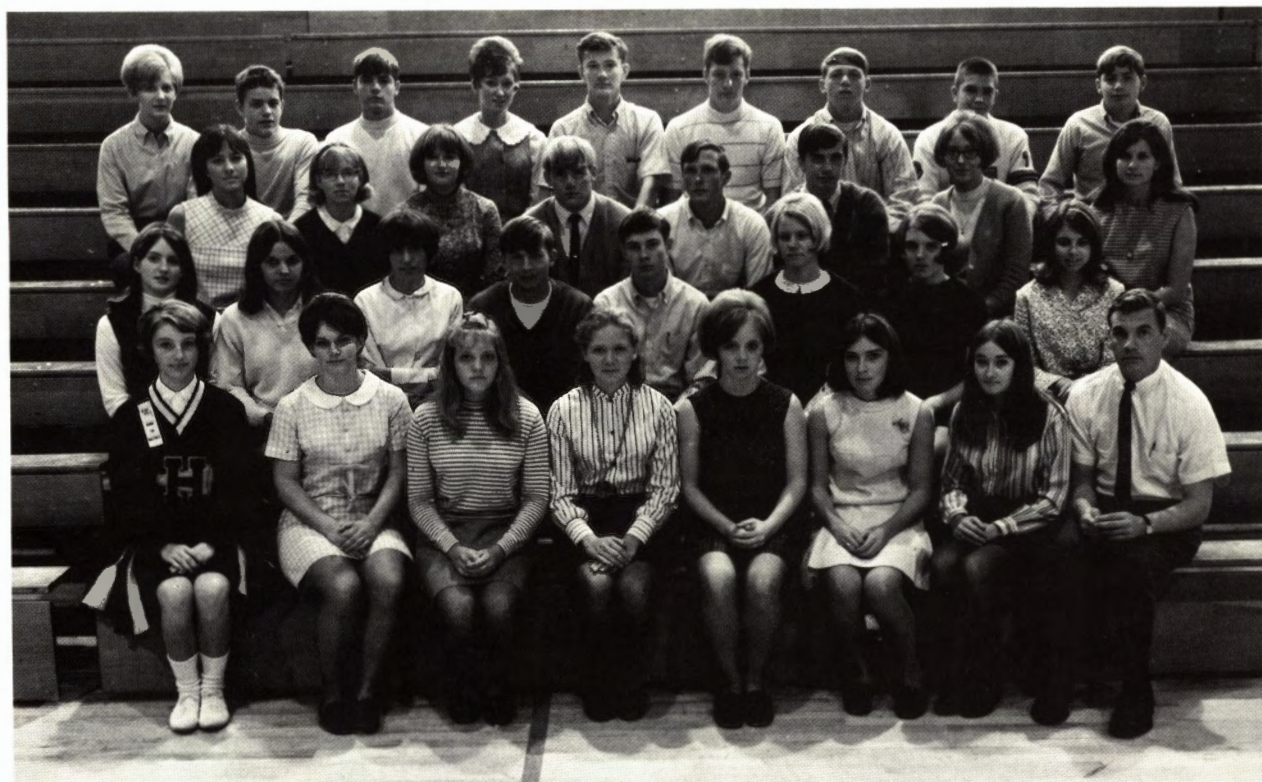

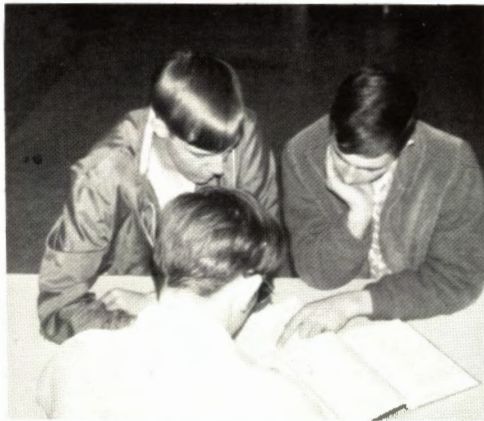

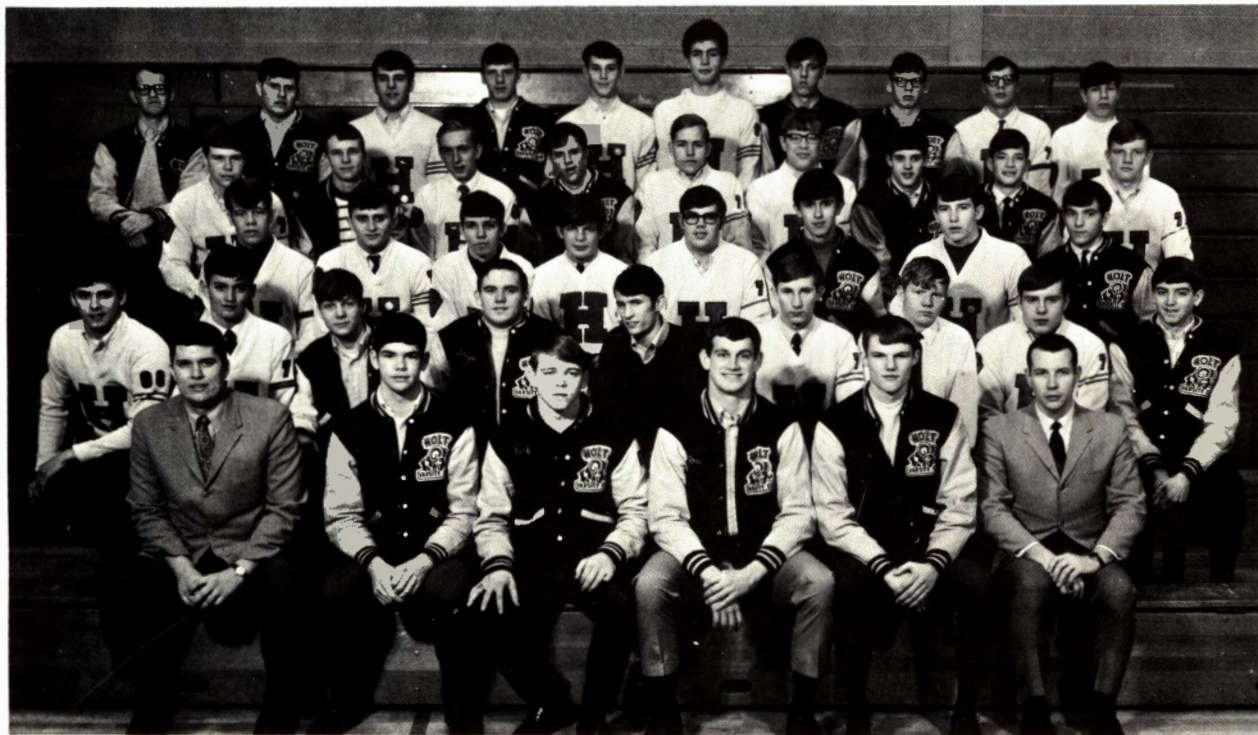

Pep Club

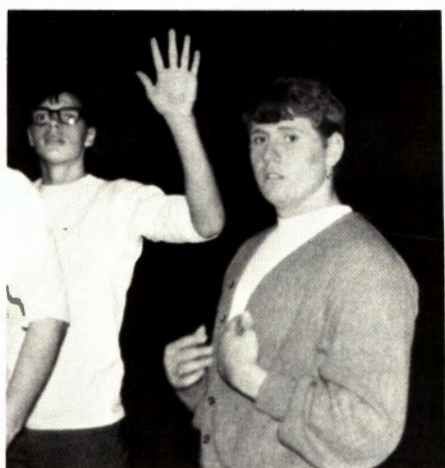

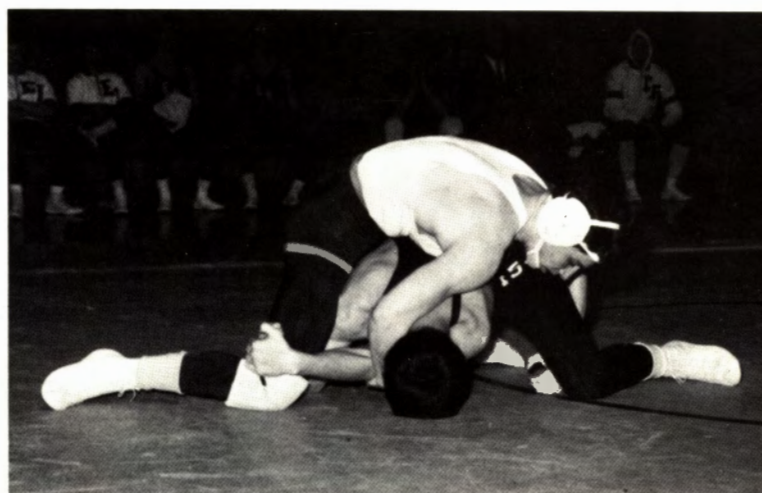
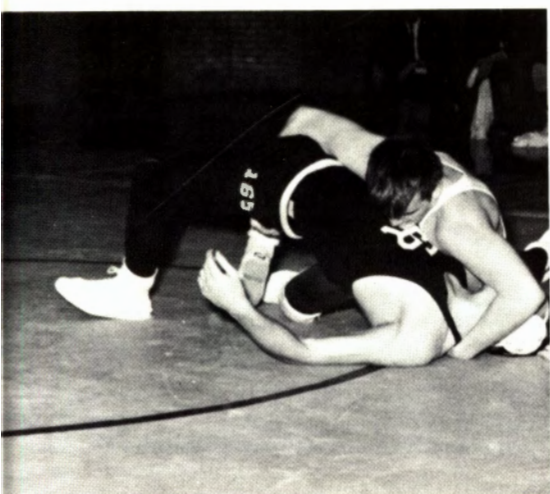
The Rams brought home Holt's first wrestling trophy when they came in second at the Michigan Center Invitationals. Soon afterwards they captured the district title and won their second trophy.

Some other of the grappler's outstanding achievements included third place in the league and regional competition and second place in the Williamston Invitationals.

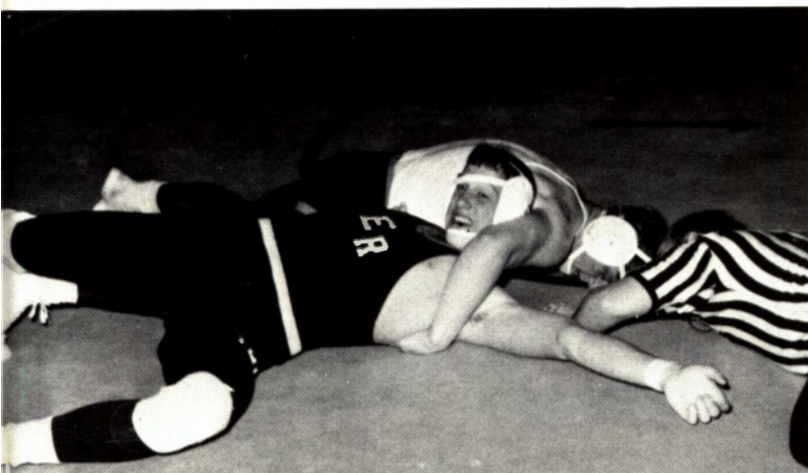
