




Wrestlers Put It All Together In 1971


Holt took second in the regionals losing to Fenton. Regional champs were D. McNeilly — 132, Hogarth and Schupp.





Under their new coach, Helmut Jagutis, this year's varsity golf squad finished the 1971 season third in the league.


Senior Mark Fiasky broke the course record for Holt by shooting a two under par 33.


