# *The History of Holt Public Schools*

Before 1830, Michigan was almost unknown to anyone east of Lake Erie, except for the early explorers and a few fur traders. Detroit was a small trading post with a few scattered houses, stores and piers for shipping purposes. The only other trading posts were Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti. Most of the state was covered with pine and hardwood forests. There were many small lakes, crystal clear, with thousands of fish waiting to be caught and cooked over open fires. Many Indians inhabited the area, all members of the Algonquin nation. The predominant tribes were the Chippewas, Huron, Potawatomi, Ottawa, Miami and Menominee.

People in central and northern Europe and England heard about the new territory, which to them sounded like an opportunity to begin again in a new and fertile land free from the oppressions of the monarchs of Europe. When the first obstacles of pioneer life had been overcome, schools were of great importance. Delhi Township, in particular, was a hard area in which to settle. The land was low and swampy, covered with giant hardwood trees, with a dense undergrowth of ferns, grape vines and low shrubs.

The earliest settlers in Delhi township were Frederick Luther and John Norris, coming in the spring of 1837. Others arriving soon after were William Wood, Joseph Wilson and Philander Morton. These families settled in the northern part of the township near what is now Jolly Road. The Thorburn, Aldrich, King and Lott families also came to Delhi in this period, finding that after the low, swampy ground was drained it proved to be very fertile and produced fine crops.

No settlement of any size was founded before 1840. Holt, or Delhi Center as it was then called, was a cluster of log cabins minus a post office, store or school. Anyone wishing to purchase supplies had to journey by way of oxcart to Jackson or Ann Arbor over narrow winding trails. Due to the long distance between neighbors, and the fact that virtually no certified teachers had come from the East, school was taught by a local woman in the neighborhood who had a degree of formal education. Generally, school was attended by only the younger children, as the older children were needed to assist in the farm work. Books were few, making learning methods rather crude. Bibles were plentiful and they were often substituted as readers, spellers, grammar books, and for chapel services which started the day's work.

The first teacher hired by a Holt School Board was

Miss Lydia Wells, who came to Delhi in 1841 from Chenango County, New York. Miss Wells taught during the winter of 1841-42, and had the proud distinction of becoming the first bride in Delhi Township in July of 1842. Miss Wells married Mr. William Robbins of Alameda Township and spent the rest of her life on a farm near Holt.

Other schools were established as settlers filtered into the area. Among the early schools were Lott, located at the corner of Pine Tree and Dell Roads, built in 1844, the North School which opened in 1842, Harper in 1845, Grovenburg in 1847 and Island School in the late 1840's. For many years there were twelve school districts in Delhi. In 1906 the schools were reorganized with some of the country schools going into other districts. Later other schools became part of Holt District. These were Gunn, started in 1867, the Dunn in 1856 and the Nichols in 1876. Of these three schools, Gunn was the only one to have any recorded history. Miss Hilda Menger, a native of Holt, and the daughter of George and Caroline Widman Menger, had the following to say about the beginnings of the Gunn School:

"Gunn School, Delhi District No. 7, began as a log school in a small clearing on the west side of the corner where S. Washington and W. Holt Roads meet.

In June, 1930, the Gunn School Community Club sent invitations to the former pupils, teachers, and residents stating that the event would celebrate the school's sixty-third year. Apparently the older people in 1930 knew that the school began in 1867.

The log school building must have been very simple. We have a vague recollection that our mother spoke of benches to sit on. The school was well protected from the winter storms. The woods came to the edge of the school yard on two sides. Across West Holt Road to the south was a sizeable pond where the boys and girls could get themselves wet and late for school, catching minnows in their hands."

The stone plaque set into the brick above the porch of the building which still stands on the site bears the words "Delhi District No. 7 - 1866." Mr. J. K. Moore, present owner of the land, has the ninety-nine year lease which was given the tenth day of September, 1886, by Charles A. Gunn to the School



District No. 7 for the sum of twenty-five dollars.

Another area resident who attended a country school near Holt is Mrs. Elethea Lamoreaux, who attended the Grovenburg School. She reports the following:

"I started to school in 1897. My first teacher was John Aren. He was a Holt resident at that time, and afterwards became a dentist at Newberry, Michigan, then later at Lansing for many years. Some of the teachers were Howard Noeth, Henry Palen, Bessie Flarety, a Miss Cole, Emma Thompson, Hazel Hilliard and Zella Gunn. In 1906-07 there were 34 pupils at Grovenburg, of which 18 are presently living. I believe the Grovenburg family were the first settlers. Others were the Thompsons, Pratts, Norths, Tookers and McCues. My brother, Glenn, and I walked one and a quarter miles to school. There was a Christmas program held at the Grovenburg Church, across from the school house on Grovenburg Road."

In 1852, a frame building was erected in Holt to replace the old log structure. It stood on the site of the present Junior High building, and served as the village school until 1875. This building later became a home, barn and garage and was razed during the early part of this century.

In 1865, the name of the village was changed from Delhi Center to Holt, in honor of the Post Master General at that time, William Holt. The main reason for this change was that the mail for Delhi Center was constantly getting confused with that of Delhi Mills in Shiawassee County. In 1870, W. H. Cornwell, the reporter from Holt to the Ingham County News, wrote the following description of the village to his hometown paper in Holley, New York:

"The little village of Delhi is beautifully situated on the line of the Jackson, Lansing and Saginaw railroad and about midway between Lansing and Mason, the county seat of Ingham County, and contains a population of about three-hundred. It has two dry goods stores, one shoe shop, two churches, one union school house, one hotel, a doctor's office, a blacksmith shop, and a grocery store. The farming community around about are mostly from the State of New York, except for about one-third who are of German extraction and originally from Ohio. The general thrift and enterprise of the inhabitants is unexcelled."



In 1875, a brick building was built to replace the frame building of 1852. It was a two-story structure, of red brick, with an ornate cupola for the bell. The cost of construction and furnishings came to roughly \$2300. The primary grades, one through six, were housed on the first floor, while the intermediate pupils, seventh and eighth, were on the second story. Two teachers were hired for the forty to sixty pupils. This school was the largest in the area with the Maple Grove school located on M-99 the second.

Holt's growth was minimal until 1908 when the "Interurban" tracks were laid through the town, thus enabling people to catch a train as early as 5:00 a.m. to Lansing. The tracks were placed behind the present day Hitchen's Drug Store, and can be traced north to Keller Road. Steam trains continued to deliver mail to Holt and passenger service was available until the 1940's. The depot was located on Depot Street and was razed in the early 1950's. Holt experienced such an amazing growth after the coming of the "Interurban" that the saying was heard through the town that "Lansing would soon become a suburb of Holt."

Disaster for the schools struck on November 11, 1914, when the red brick school building burned to the ground. Kindergarten teacher, Hazel Rinkle, now living in Dimondale, has the following to say of those days:

"In the fall of 1914, the old two-story



building burned and we were in temporary quarters for the rest of the year. Two rooms, fourth through the tenth grades were in the town hall, and the primary room was in the basement of the (English) Methodist Church, directly across the street."

A meeting was called by the District Board consisting of the following men on December 19, 1914: J. J. Manz, H. E. Gunn, J. D. Thorburn, George Wilcox, and C. V. Keller. These five men voted to approve an eight-thousand dollar loan to build a new school house. When the recommendation was presented to the voters it passed by a 54-12 majority. The new school was built on the site of the old building, which is the site of the present Junior High School. The building consisted of three classrooms with additional classroom space available in the basement.

By 1923, it was apparent that changes were necessary in regards to Holt Schools. Mrs. Alida Chapman, long time resident and local historian, described those years in this way:

"With the influx of new people, especially the young married couples with children, the school which had been a three room building caring for District No. 1 pupils and tuition pupils that came to the ten-grade school, now began to burst at the seams. Two basement rooms had been equipped for classes and the fourth and fifth grades were in the east room of the basement and the sixth and seventh grades were in the west room. However, under the stairway leading to the basement was a 500 gallon tank for the chemical toilets. The odor from this tank was so bad that neither room could have the door open for cross ventilation. Talk started around the village for adding more rooms to the school, and, of course, there had to be a bond issue raised and extra money received for operating expenses and teachers' salaries. In 1923, after the seventh millage vote passed, an addition was built across the front of the school consisting of three classrooms, an office and hall on the first floor, an assembly room, chemistry laboratory and one classroom on the second floor."

It was also in 1923, that the first formal Superintendent of Schools, Mr. Larned Goodrich, was employed by Holt Public Schools. From his years in Holt, Mr. Goodrich offers the following:



"I went to Holt in 1923 as Superintendent of the Holt Schools. We had ten grades at that time. I taught all ninth and tenth grade subjects in addition to my administrative duties. During this year an addition was built to the school and the eleventh grade was added. In the fall of 1925 we added the twelfth grade and becoming accredited by the University of Michigan graduated the first class of nine members in 1926.

We had a complete program of athletics and played basketball in the old Town-hall. People watching the games stood along the sidelines. The ceiling was very low and made it a very difficult place to play. However, we had good teams and fine school spirit. It was about this time that the school decided to select school colors. I suggested Brown and Gold, which was adopted by the student body and remains the school colors today. This adoption took place in 1925.

The five teachers at Holt in 1923 were Miss Barnes, Miss Favorite, later to become Mrs. Goodrich, Miss Elliott, Miss Ackley and myself."

At the time of the first graduating class in 1926, Mr. Paul Straight was the high school Principal. The first Baccalaureate service was held at the Presbyterian Church on May 23, 1926, with Class Night on May 31, 1926, at the North Holt Methodist Church. Accordingly gray leather diplomas with old rose lining were presented by School Board President, Verne Kellar. Several other "firsts" occurred in 1926 - a



choir was organized by Miss Evelyn Rozen and the first Senior Play, entitled "The Little Clodhopper" was presented under her direction. Additional classroom space was added in 1926, with a wing built on the west side of the building consisting of four classrooms on both the first and second stories.

Athletics came in strong during this period. The first league in which Holt played was the Ingham County League and included Holt, Mason, Stockbridge, Haslett, Fowlerville, Dansville, Okemos, and Williamston. Non-league games were played with Charlotte, Webberville, Dimondale, and Walter French (previous to adding the twelfth grade). Some of the early coaches were Charles Mann, Paul Straight, L. G. Goodrich, Lawrence Hiller, and Rev. Leonard Andrews, who was instrumental in starting the Tennis Team in 1928.

The Parent Teacher Association was organized in 1923 under the direction of Mrs. Marguerite Wolcott, teacher and one-time Principal of the Holt School. The first officers were: President, Ernest Clever; Vice-President, Stella Gunn; Secretary, Tessa Elliott; and members as follows: Harry and Alida Chapman, May Clever and Mrs. Warren. This group held many fund-raising affairs to raise money for new school equipment after the fire of 1914. This organization has continued until the present with groups active in all of the elementary buildings.

During the 1926-27 school year, the first Holt High School Orchestra was begun by Miss Evelyn Rosen. At that time, Holt did not have a band. The Band was formed under the direction of Larned Goodrich in 1929, with Miss Alberta Phillips as director. According to the 1930 annual, the band was arranged due to the efforts of the Frank Holton Company, who made musical instruments, by offering to take any student who had some experience in music and any who desired to buy a musical instrument, and provide a teacher for 12 weeks free of cost in order that a band might be formed. This group has continually provided fine music for the community of Holt and has been a source of pride to citizens and students alike. Directors from 1930 have been: Evelyn Rosen, Alberta Phillips, Stuart Openlander, Rex Huelett, Don Tatroe and since 1952, Gerald Winters. The Holt Bands have earned many awards and have turned out many fine musicians over the years.

In 1935 an addition consisting of the gym, cafeteria and four classrooms was built. This work was done by the WPA, a federal agency for the alleviation of unemployment during the Depression years.

After World War II, several new subdivisions were opened allowing many families to move into the Holt area. Overcrowding necessitated the building of two temporary buildings behind the present Junior

High building to house the elementary grades. Later they served as music and shop classrooms. They were torn down in 1963 to facilitate an addition to the Junior High.

Barett Vorce, High School Principal in 1947 under Superintendent, Ben Yates, describes this period:

"Holt has always enjoyed an advantage in the recruitment of its teaching personnel due to its proximity to Michigan State University. I realized this most clearly as I worked with a very talented and exciting group of young and veteran teachers. There was a preponderance of young teachers whose enthusiasm and blissful ignorance was often a trial for the veteran teachers and for the community as well. Some of these young teachers "Hell-bent to save the schools" were soon labeled as "young Turks" and I'm sure they exulted in this. Early in our stay, the staff began working on the development of a core-type approach to Junior and even Senior High Social Sciences and English. Almost as soon, they voted to discard report cards in the secondary grades emulating an earlier move by the elementary schools. Holt was, to our best knowledge, the first High School in Michigan to adopt Parent-Student-Teacher conferences in grades 7 through 12.

I'm sure that more people will remember the construction of the high school football field with greater clarity than they will recall changes in curriculum, because so many people - kids, parents and other school patrons were so actively involved. I'll never forget the two days and nights during which we virtually closed school, commandeered commu-







nity trucks and trailers to dig up field sod from Carl Dougherty's then laid in on the area which had been hastily and voluntarily graded by Mr. Savage. It was really a tremendous project and there were so many people who gave so willingly of their time and effort. Bill Harris, Hugh Smyth, Bill Fudge, Bud Dart, Marshall Coolidge, Orville Hitchens, Jack Armour and so many others worked with kids and school people."

This new field was on the corner of Aurelius and Sycamore Street. The first game was played there on October 1, 1948 against Dansville, with Holt winning. The football coach at that time was Fred Lawrence, with Myron Smith as his assistant. During this season, Bruce DePue set a school record that has yet to be broken when he scored 38 points against Haslett.

With so many young families coming to the area, elementary classroom space was again badly needed by 1948. Accordingly, a building and site fund millage was passed, which provided for the building of Midway School on Spahr Avenue. Its doors were opened in the fall of 1949, thus beginning a new era of education for Holt. The school had changed from the old village school concept (three room, seventy-five students, five teachers) to over 1,000 students housed in two buildings with thirty-five teachers. Midway first consisted of seven classrooms, with later additions in 1954, 1956, 1960 and 1967.

Another bond issue passed in the fall of 1952 for \$360,000 which was used to build Sycamore and Elliott schools, both of which opened in the fall of 1953. Elliott school was named for a much-loved teacher in Holt, Miss Tessa Elliott. Miss Elliott came to Holt in 1918 and taught for the following thirty-eight years. She commanded the respect of two generations of Holt children and taught perhaps as many as 1,200 students in her years in Holt.

Additional growth was constant during the 1950's and early 1960's. Further additions were made to the elementary schools, and in 1958-59 a new high school was constructed. The cost of the building was \$1,000,000. Although originally designed as a campus style outlay, and buildings have since been joined together, with remodelings and additions continuing to the present. The formal dedication was held in October, 1959, with Gov. G. Mennen Williams, as the guest speaker. This left the old school building on Holt Road to serve as a Junior High until the fall of 1976 when it will change to the 6-7 Middle School.

Athletic teams continued to flourish. Basketball under the coaching of Mr. Dan Hovanesian and football under Mr. Walter Pawlowski and Mr. Darold Briggs provided the community with many exciting, victorious teams. Girls Basketball was formed in 1955 under the coaching of Mrs. Martha Marvin and has continued to bring home many honors. Wrestling, Track and Tennis teams also experienced many fine seasons and created a strong following



among the students and community.

Mr. Ronald Allen joined the staff in 1957 and has directed the vocal music in the Junior and Senior High Schools since that time. Students and adults have enjoyed the concerts, operettas and musicals performed each year under his direction.

In 1962, the voters of the Holt and Dimondale School Districts voted favorably on a merger by annexation proposition. The former Dimondale High School was razed after the merger and is currently the site of the Windsor Township Library. The Dimondale Elementary School on Walnut Street accommodates the students from the former Dimondale Schools and part of the Maple Grove and outlying Holt areas. The building was built in 1956, with additions in 1961, 1963, and 1965.

In 1970, additions were again under construction at the Senior High School. The addition included the pool, auditorium, music rooms and classrooms. In 1972, the auditorium was dedicated to Dr. Maurice

Pernert, who had been Superintendent of Schools from 1958 until his death. The newly constructed athletic field and facilities were dedicated in September of 1972, to Dr. Frank Troost, who had been the team physician for thirty-four years, from 1930 to 1964.

At the present time the new 8-9 building is under construction and is planned to open in the fall of 1976. This building is located on West Holt Road.

There has been a continual history of educational excellence in the Holt Schools. Time and space would not permit the recording of all of those whose personal efforts have gone into the making of our present system. Through the efforts of the Holt Public Schools staff and the continued support of the community, we are sure that our schools will continue in the tradition of years past of scholastic, athletic and musical excellence among its students.
