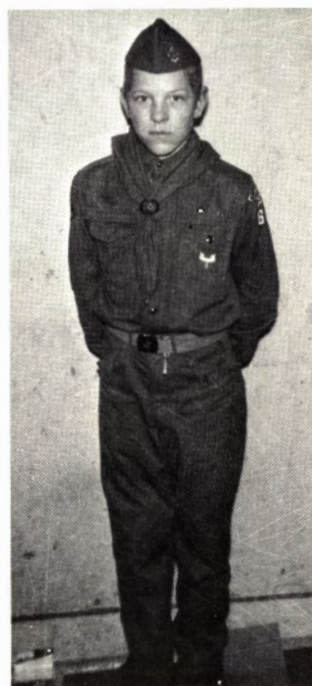
Jerry has also maintained a good record as a student at Leslie High.
